



LADIES SUMMER HOCKEY LEAGUE

RULES FOR TEAM ENTRIES - 2010

- To register your team in the Ladies Summer Hockey League, send your team deposit in the amount of \$1000, payable to "Ladies Summer Hockey League", along with your Team Application Form, to 24 Greenbriar Road, Brampton ON L6S 1V6.
- Any changes to the tentative team list should be submitted prior to the first night since the game sheets will be printed ahead of time.
- All players/coaches/bench staff must register by completing and signing the Team List (which will be provided the first night) or a Team Member Application Form, **prior** to participating.
- **Final team lists, with signatures, must be completed by June 16, 2010 – no changes to the roster will be allowed after this date.**
- If a player is less than 18 years of age, the player should complete a Team member Application Form, which the parent/guardian must also sign to indicate their approval for the player to participate.
- Team contacts are responsible for assuring that each and every player/ coach/bench staff understands the rules for team entries as well as the Ladies Summer Hockey League Rules and Regulations.
- A team may consist of 15 players and 2 goaltenders.
- Teams **may not borrow players** from another team, with the exception of a goaltender*.
- The game will be forfeited by a score of 3-0 if an unregistered player participates - Individual goals and assists will not be credited, however, penalty minutes will.
- ***NEW THIS YEAR:** If your goaltender cannot make a regular season game, you are required to find your own replacement. If this replacement is not already registered with the Ladies Summer Hockey League, please advise Laura at (905) 790-0911 so that she can register before the game. Playoff replacement goalies must be registered with the Ladies Summer Hockey League.
- Teams should supply their own locks for the dressing room.
- A spare bag of equipment, including neck guards, is available – please return items right after your game.
- Any team whose penalty minutes exceed 50 will be issued a warning. If the penalty minutes reach 75, a \$50 fine will be assessed to the team.
- The Ladies Summer Hockey League reserves the right to place teams in the most appropriate division and to refuse the application of any player/coach/bench staff.

TEAM PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

WEDNESDAY NIGHT LEAGUE – Team Entry Fee is \$3500. A deposit of \$1000 must accompany the Team Application Form and may be post-dated up until April 1st 2010. A second payment of \$1250 is due the first night, and the remaining \$1250 is due by June 16th 2010.

Failure to meet the above payment terms may result in additional charges for each week the team has an outstanding balance.
